Make a Tag Using Alcohol Ink

Supplies

- Adirondack Alcohol Ink
- Canned Air
- Glossy Cardstock
- Stamp
- Archival Ink Pad
- Hole Puncher
- Ribbon



Directions

Before you begin, die cut the cardstock into the desired design. Also, be sure to use glossy cardstock and not gloss photo paper. The photo paper contains solvents that will react the alcohol ink.

1. Apply drops of alcohol ink onto the glossy side of the cardstock.
2. Spray the canned air to the drop to spread them across the cardstock.
3. Set aside to let dry.
4. Stamp the tag with a sentiment or favorite saying using a stamp and Archival Ink pad.
5. After it has dried, punch a hole in the tag and add ribbon.
