Antique Display Box

Supplies

Unfinished Wood Shadow Box
Graphic 45 Paper
Red, Gold and Silver Acrylic Paint
Foam Paint Brush
Vintaj & Tim Holtz Idea-ology
Findings & Knob
E6000 Glue
String or Thin Ribbon
Collage Pauge



Directions

1. Paint the unfinished wood shadow box red. Let dry completely.
2. Use the gold and silver paint to create a distressed look by brushing the paint over the red in light, quick strokes.
3. Cut the Graphic 45 paper to fit on the back and sides of the shadow box cubbies. Adhere the paper using the Collage Pauge. Let dry.
4. Glue on knob and other embellishments.
5. Cut strips of ribbon to hang on the side of your shadow box. Glue embellishments to the ribbon. Glue the ends of the ribbon to the top edge of the shadow box and let your ribbons hang down the side like tassels.
6. Display and enjoy!
