Dad's Pinstripe Shadowbox

Materials

Vinyl saying: "A Dad is someone who carries pictures in his wallet where his money used to be"

8"x8" Shadowbox Frame

8"x8" Pinstripe scrapbook paper

1 Vellum sheet, cut to 7"x7"

4 Black Photo Corners

8"x8" plastic sheet (transparency)

Black ribbon, optional

Scissors

Glass Cleaner

Vinyl applicator, or plastic card

Sheet of lined paper, optional



Instructions

1. Take apart the shadowbox and clean both sides of the glass with cleaner.
2. Lay the frame backing right side up and place the scrapbook paper on top with the lines placed vertically.
3. Carefully place the photo corners on the vellum sheet and attach to the center of the pinstripe paper. Place the transparency on top of stack.
4. Lay the glass over the lined paper and make sure it's straight. The paper will work as a guide. Prep the vinyl by burnishing with applicator (or card) for a good seal. Remove the backing from the packaged vinyl. Carefully place the vinyl on the glass making sure that the lines of text are straight. Burnish the saying onto the surface and remove the top paper beginning in a corner and "rocking" the paper back and forth.
5. Clean any fingerprints from the glass and re-assemble the shadowbox.
6. You may wish to attach a ribbon to the hook on the back for a more finished look.
