Adirondack Alcohol Ink
Ranger Blending Solution
Vinyl Rub On
Tim Holtz Idea-ology Findings
Rhinestones



Directions

1. Using your blending tool apply alcohol ink to one corner of blender. Dap blender all over suitcase case in a polka dot fashion.
2. Repeat this with second color choice.
3. Using opposite end of blending tool add blending solution then dap and swirl all over the luggage until you have a marbled effect. You can add more color or blending solution to acquire desired color.
4. Once ink is dry (half hour) add desired scrapbook paper to suit case using Mod Podge, make sure to coat over all of suit case to give a finished look (allow to dry overnight).
5. Once surface is completely dry add vinyl rub on.
6. Using E6000 glue adhere clock parts and Idea-ology findings. Metal parts may be colored with alcohol ink if desired.
7. Add vinyl, rhinestones and paper flowers.
8. Enjoy!
