### No-Sew Fabric Banner

#### Supplies

Fabric Panel

Multi Purpose Fabric

Mod Podge Matte

1 1/2" to 2" craft brush

Wooden Dowel

Wire, Ribbon or Cord for hanging

Scissors or Rotary Cutter

*Glue, Stapler or Sewing Machine (See step 1)*

*Optional: craft paint, finials (for dowel ends)*



#### Directions

*Note: Make sure that Multi Purpose fabric is wide, or wider than panel. Also, the dowel should be 2"-6" wider than the top of the panel. Display banner outside, protected from the elements.*

1. First, make a channel for the dowel by folding down the top section of multi purpose fabric. Secure with Hot Glue, Stapling or Stitching (either by hand or with sewing machine)
2. Using the paint brush coat the top of the multi purpose fabric with Mod Podge.
3. Working in sections, slowly lay the fabric panel on top of the multi purpose fabric while the Mod Podge is wet.
4. Apply several coats, one at a time, to the top of the fabric panel. Allow to dry completely between coats. When dry, trim the excess fabric.
5. Decorate the dowel with paint or finial knobs and feed through channel. Add wire, ribbon or cord to dowel ends.

Hang and Enjoy!
