D.I.Y. Glass Marble/Tile Magnets

Supplies

- Glass Tiles
- Decorative Paper
- Mod Podge
- E-6000
- Magnets
- Paintbrush
- Scissors



Directions

1. Trim the paper to the desired size.
2. Use the paintbrush to apply Mod Podge onto the front side of the paper (the design you want to show through the glass).
3. Place the paper onto the back of the glass tile, glue side up.
4. Completely cover the back of the paper with Mod Podge, using the paintbrush, to seal the paper to the tile.
5. Set aside to dry.
6. Once dry, apply E-6000 onto a magnet or magnet strip and glue it to the back of the glass tile.
7. Wait for the glue to completely dry before using.
