Home Banner

Materials

3 - 12 x 12 Meadowlark Papers from MME
2 - 12 x 12 Balsamic Cardstock
18" Sheer Ribbon
Foam Tape
Paper Adhesive - Zip Dry
Scallop Lace Punch
Big Bite Hole Punch
Cuttlebug
Cuttlebug Embossing Folders-Dot and Script
Banner Template
Pencil
Scissors



Instructions

Trace and cut out banner template 6 times onto the Meadowlark Paper. Edge Punch the 6 - 1 x 6 Balsamic Cardstock strips with the Scallop Lace Punch and adhere them to the top of each banner. Stack all the banners on top of each other and use the Big Bite to punch a hole in the top corners. Run all the die cuts through the Cuttlebug using the embossing folders. Lay out the banners in the order you want them to appear. Adhere the die cuts to the banner with foam tape. Draw two circles on the scraps of Meadowlark Paper. Using the scissors, cut the circle into one big long curly strip. Wind the strip around your finger to make a flower. Adhere them to the end banner die cuts. Cut the sheer ribbon into 8" strips to tie the banners together.
