Paper Flower Frame

Supplies

- 1 Unfinished Frame
- Patterned Scrapbooking Paper
- Acrylic Paint
- Alcohol Ink
- Hot Glue Gun
- Deckle Edge Scissors
- Scissors



Directions

1. Using a paintbrush, paint the frame in a desired color.
2. Set aside to let dry.

There are two types of flowers you can create for this. Here are the instructions for the rose:

3. Cut paper into 6," 4," and 3," squares.
4. Use deckle edge scissors (or tear by hand) and cut each square into a circle.
4. Mist each piece with water using a mini mister.
5. Crumple the paper, then flatten it out to let dry.
6. Use the deckle edge scissors to cut each circle into a coil. Repeat this step until all your circles are coils.
7. Wind the paper (like rolling it) to create your flower shape.
8. Using a strong adhesive, glue the bottom center of the flower to glue it on the frame.

Paper Flower Frame

The second flower has petals similar to a mum.

10. Cut a few 1.5" x 12" strips of paper and fold in half lengthwise.
11. Using scissors, make small cuts up to the edge but not all the way through.
12. Wind up and secure the flower with glue (to prevent from unraveling).
13. Set aside to let the glue dry.
14. Once dry, open up (bend) the small strips to form the flower.

If you have any open spaces in the frame that is too small to fill with a flower, you cut small leaves from the same paper to glue into those areas.

Insert a saying, quote or even photo inside the frame and it's ready to display!
