Setup Your Own Photo Booth with Props

Mustache & Lips

- Mustache Die
- Lip Die
- Black Card Stock
- Red Card Stock
- 1/8" x 12" or 3/16" x 12"
Wooden Dowels
- 527 Multi-Purpose Glue



1. Die cut the mustache onto black card stock and the lip onto red card stock. Our Die Cut Center now has the Mustache and Lip Dies. *We offer FREE use of our Die Cut Machines to our customers when used with products purchased in our store!*
2. Use 527 Multi-Purpose Glue to adhere the dowel to the mustache & lip. *Creativity Tip! Add glitter to your mustache & lip die cuts or use other colored card stock.*

Speech Bubbles

- Wooden Speech Bubbles
- 1/4" x 12 inch. Dowels
- DecoArt Americana Chalkboard Paint
- 527 Multi-Purpose Glue



1. Using the paintbrush, apply the chalkboard paint to the front and sides of the speech bubble. We recommend applying two coats.
2. Let dry for 1 hour in between coats and then let it cure for 24 hours. Lightly rub chalk over the surface to condition.
3. For these speech bubbles, you have to use a dowel that is at least 1/4" thick due to their weight, so you can use a thicker dowel.
4. Once dry, glue the dowel to the back of the speech bubble.

Crafting Tip! For best results, apply a multi-purpose sealer to the wood before applying the chalkboard paint.

Accessories

Add a table next to the photo booth with items, such as:

- Feather Boas
- Crowns and Tiaras
- Hats
- Glasses and Sunglasses
- Masks
- Wands
- Wings
- Gloves



Backdrop

We created a backdrop using our popular Ruffle Fabric by using clothespins to pin the fabric to twine, and hung it on the wall.

You can create a backdrop for your photo booth using: Streamers, Garland, Paper, Fabric.



Be sure your backdrop is at least 4' x 4' to allow two people within the frame. You may want to measure the area by setting up your camera to see the coverage of the backdrop.

Now, all you have to do is secure your camera to a tripod and set the timer to allow people to take their own photos. That way, no one has to be the designated booth attendant to take the photos.

Then, let the fun begin!
