Recipe Box

Supplies:

Wood Recipe Box
Ranger Adirondack Color Wash: Espresso
Ranger Adirondack Alcohol Inks: Silver and Copper Metal Mixatives
Ranger Adirondack Espresso Dye Ink
Ranger Perfect Pearls Copper
Ranger Perfect Pearls Brush
VersaMagic Watermark Ink
Foam Ink Applicator Tool
Tim Holtz Wood Stamp "Number Collage"
Tim Holtz Alterations Bigz Die "Gadget Gears"
Tim Holtz Idea-ology "Swivel Clasps"
Tim Holtz Cling Stamps "Mini Cirque Alphabet"
Grungepaper
Cuttlebug
Cuttlebug Embossing Folder-Swiss Dot
Cream Cardstock
Corner Rounder
May Arts Twine – 2 yds
Thumb Tacks
Bird Charms
Copper Wire
Pencil
Baby Wipes and Paper Towels
Rubber Gloves
Ranger Inkessential NonStick Craft Mat
Studio Line Matte Medium (Adhesive)

Instructions

1. Place Wood Recipe Box in a large box cardboard box and completely cover with the Ranger Adirondack Color Wash: Espresso. Let dry.
2. Stamp the word family onto the cream cardstock with the Tim Holtz Cling Stamps "Mini Cirque Alphabet". Corner Round the stamped piece and set aside.
3. Apply the Ranger Adirondack Alcohol Inks: Silver and Copper Metal Mixatives to the Grungepaper Gadget Gears Die Cuts using the Foam Applicator tools. Let dry and run through the Cuttlebug using the Cuttlebug Embossing Folder-Swiss Dot. Set aside.
4. Once the wood box is dry, sand the edges of the box.

5. Adhere the "Family" strip to the front of the box using the Studio Line Matte Medium
6. Randomly stamp the Tim Holtz Wood Stamp "Number Collage" onto the box using the VersaMagic Watermark Ink and dust the images with the Ranger Perfect Pearls Copper. Brush off extra.
7. Adhere the Gears and Gadgets to the box using the Thumb Tacks and the Studio Line Matte Medium.
8. Attach one of the Gears to the Tim Holtz Idea-ology "Swivel Clasps" and attach the bird charm to the jump ring at the other end. Adhere to the center of the Gears on the top of the box with the thumb tack.
9. Wrap twine around the bottom of the box and tie off in the back. Wrap the copper wire around a pencil and then tie around the twine on the front of the box.
