## Minkee/Fleece Scarf

### **Materials Needed:**

9" x 60" Fleece  
9" x 60" Minkee fabric  
Scissors

Size 12 Universal Point sewing machine needle

**Adding Trim:** 1/2 yard beaded trim or fringe or both

**Sew Tips for Minkee:** Adjust the stitch length longer, 12 stitches per inch. Pin 1" apart and stitch with the Minkee face down.

**Fabric Tips:** Minkee and Fleece won't shrink. Adding trims require hand washing.

### **Instructions for TieKnot Scarf:**

1. Trim the ends of both the fleece and Minkee to even the pieces.
2. Pin Minkee scarf to Fleece scarf, wrong sides together.
3. Stitch 3/8" seam allowance on the long sides of the scarf. Leaving both ends open. Turn inside out.
4. Cut through the fleece and the minkee 1/2" fringe 4" long at both short ends of the scarf.

### **Instructions for Adding Trims:**

1. Repeat steps 1 through 4 above.
2. Fold inside the 3/8" seam allowance all around the bottom and both ends.
3. Fold the ends of the trim under sandwich between the fleece and minkee. Pin in place.
4. Stitch in place 1/4" from the edge and continue all the way around the fleece scarf.
