Mother's Day Shadowbox Frame with Flower

Supply List:

2 - 12"x12" patterned papers

1-2 - 12"x12" solid papers

Acrylic Paint in coordinating color

Wooden Letters (your choice)

Silk Flowers (optional)

1 - 12"x12" Shadowbox Frame

At least 2 - 4"x6" photographs

Tools:

Double-sided Adhesive

Scissors

Foam Brush

Hot Glue Gun or E6000



Instructions:

- 1. Paint the wood letters and allow them to dry completely. Take apart the shadowbox and clean both sides of the glass.
- 2. Take the back off the shadowbox and adhere one sheet of patterned paper to the back. Cut 4 strips of the same paper to cover the inside lip of the frame.
- 3. Create a "frame" for your photos by cutting a piece of solid colored paper an inch larger than your photo. Adhere the photo to the top of the colored paper.
- 4. Carefully hot glue the wood letters inside the frame. Arrange and adhere your photos on the back inside of the frame.
- 5. Put the shadowbox back together and add embellishments, like a silk flower, with a hot glue gun (or E6000 glue).
