### Tin Embossed Star

#### Supplies

- Metal Star
- Patterned Scrapbooking Paper
- Mod Podge
- Scissors
- Ribbon
- Foam Brush



#### Directions

1. To get started, create a template by tracing the areas of the star you want to cover with paper. This way, you can cut the patterns easily to glue right on.
2. Cut your paper patterns using the templates. You should have 10 cut outs when finished (if you are covering all sides of the star with paper).
3. Use Mod Podge to adhere the paper onto the star.
4. Set aside to let dry.
5. Measure and trim ribbon of your choice to wrap around the star.
6. Once the glue is dry on the star, tie the ribbon on.

Now, it's ready to display!
