## Dad's Wall Plaque with Hook

### Materials

Wood Slat Plaque  
Scrapbook Paper  
Ink Pad (in coordinating color)  
Vinyl saying: "Any Man can be a Father, but it takes a Special Person to be a Dad".  
Mod Podge or spray adhesive  
Paper Trimmer  
Plastic vinyl applicator (or card)  
Hole punch (optional)

### Instructions

1. Unwind the metal wire hanger from the plaque and set aside.
2. Place the plaque face down onto the right side of your scrapbook paper and trace the shape. Cut out shape with paper trimmer or scissors. Punch holes in the paper where the wire will feed through.
3. Using the ink pad, ink around the edges of the paper to create a "rustic" or "weathered" look.
4. Adhere the paper to the plaque with either Mod Podge or spray adhesive. Let dry completely.
5. Prepare the vinyl by burnishing with applicator (or card) for a good seal. Remove the backing from the packaged vinyl. Carefully place the vinyl on the dried paper. Burnish the saying onto the surface and remove the top paper beginning in a corner and "rocking" the paper back and forth.
6. Carefully string the wire back through the holes of the plaque. Enjoy!
