Wooden Album or Notebook

Materials

Wooden Album Cover

Tattered Angels Glimmer Mist: tattered leather & jazz blue

Flower Soft peel off border stickers in gold

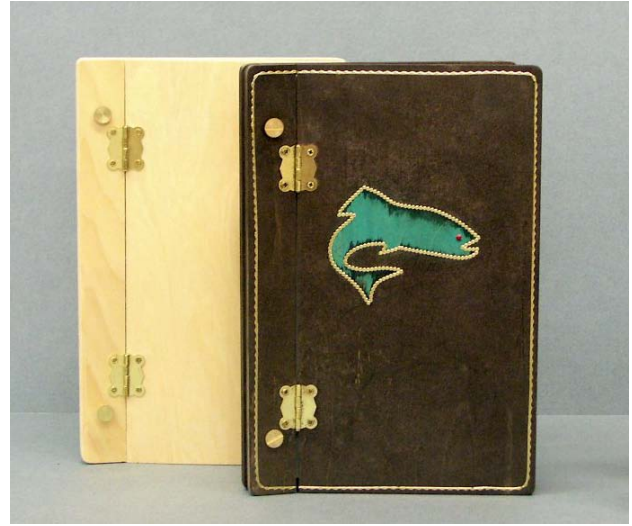
Stencil Material—plastic or chipboard

“Nail head” type embellishment

AccuCut Fish die-cut, available at Die-cut Center

Removable Adhesive

Fine Grit Sandpaper



Instructions

1. Unscrew posts from wood album leaving hinges on. Lightly sand the entire surface.
2. You will use both pieces of your die-cut stencil for this project. Be sure to leave ample room around the cut out shape.
3. Using removable adhesive, place the stencil relief (the one with the fish removed) on the front cover making sure the fish is centered and about 2.5"-3" from the top. Using the Tattered Angels "Jazz Blue", spray color over fish shape and let dry completely. When dry, remove the stencil relief, some bleeding may have occurred.
4. Using removable adhesive, place the fish shaped stencil on the front cover - be sure to line it up with the fish shape. Using the Tattered Angels "Tattered Leather", spray color over entire front of album. Remove the stencil when dry, again, some bleeding may have occurred.
5. You may wish to add more layers of color to achieve your desired look. To do so, simply repeat steps 3 and 4 until you are satisfied with the color.
6. Once the cover is dry, use the "Tattered Leather" spray to finish the rest of the

album. Let dry.

7. Using the gold trim Flower Soft stickers, make a border around the edge of the front cover. Create a border around the fish shape with the same stickers.
8. Embellish with a gem, bead, or other "nail head" type piece for the fish eye.

Optional:

A. You may want to use this as an album, notebook or scrapbook. For an album: insert photo refill pages of your choice. For a notebook: cut paper to size and punch/drill holes where the posts line up. Once you have the paper sheets made, you can scrapbook onto those pages too!
