

Christmas Frame Wreath

Supplies

- Frame
- Ornaments
- Spray Paint
- Bow
- Ribbon
- Scissors



You can choose to use any frame you would like, but for this project, Melody specifically chose a frame with a very ornate design.



1. Paint the entire frame using spray paint.

If you have an ornate frame, the paint will accentuate all the beautiful details.

We recommend using a paint that is semi-glossy or glossy, unless you prefer a matte finish.

- 2. Set the frame aside to let dry.
- 3. Measure and cut strips of ribbon to hang ornaments or other adornments from the frame.

- 4. Tie ornaments to each strip of ribbon, then tie the ribbon to the middle top of the frame to let the ornaments hang in the open area of the frame.
- 5. Using a pre-made bow or you can make a bow, attach it to the area to cover up the tie ribbons.
