### DIY: Photo in a Bottle Cap

#### Supplies

- 4" bottle cap
- Glue or double-sided tape
- Small easel
- Picture

#### Directions

Our bottle caps are big enough (4" round) that you have plenty of space to put a picture. Simply trace the bottom part of the bottle cap onto your picture. Cut a little smaller to fit inside the cap. You can use either double-sided tape or Mod Podge to adhere your picture inside the cap.

The bottle cap comes with a red ribbon for easy hanging, but we actually glued a magnet to the back too. Now you can display on any metal surface. Use our cute little easels if you prefer to display your project as you would a picture frame. Whatever way you use to display it, it will be a great hit with all your friends and family.
