

Class: Beginner Quilt Making

Class Description/Outline:

This class is designed to help beginners with the basics of quilt piecing.

Our time will focus on basic understanding of patterns, cutting fabric, sewing pieces, and assembly of quilt blocks.

Supplies Required:

2 fat quarters, 1 light in color/pattern and 1 dark in color/pattern. Thread

Machine if you have one, otherwise contact us to reserve a machine.

Basic sewing supplies (scissors, rotary cutter, pins, ruler) Mat boards are supplied.

Out of respect for instructors and other students who may suffer from allergies and sensitivities, please refrain from the use of perfumes or other heavily scented products on your class day. Thanks so much!

Class policies: Class Fees must be pre-paid and minimum enrollment must be met for all classes 48 hours prior to schedule. A 10% off discount is available at Customer Service for required class supplies and should be purchased in advance so classes may begin on time. All supplies are available when the class is scheduled, but not guaranteed to be in stock during the entire duration of the class schedule. If supplies used in the sample are not available, you may need to find alternate supplies to complete the projects. If no notification is given you will forfeit your class fee.
