

Class: Sewing Camp (Beginner)

Class Description/Outline:

This 5-day camp is for the beginner (ages 9+) who wants to learn about sewing machines, fabrics, rotary cutters, rulers and more. Each day throughout the week, we will focus on developing skills while completing a project. The goal is to make the following 5 projects by the end of the week. Note: Homework will be helpful but not necessary.

Day 1 (Monday): Bandana, Day 2 (Tuesday): Lanyard, Day 3 (Wednesday): String of Pennants, Day 4 (Thursday): Drawstring Backpack, Day 5 (Friday): Small Bin

All supplies are included in the class fee EXCEPT:

Spool of White Thread Spool of Black Thread Straight Pins Rotary Cutter or Scissors (cutting mats are available)

***Out of respect for instructors and other students who may suffer from allergies and sensitivities, please refrain from the use of perfumes or other heavily scented products on your class day. Thanks so much!

Class policies: Class Fees must be pre-paid and minimum enrollment must be met for all classes 48 hours prior to schedule. If supplies used in the sample are not available, you may need to find alternate supplies to complete the projects. Keep in mind that registrations done after 4:00 pm on Thursday may be accounted for only the following Monday, so sign up early for weekend classes!
