

## Class: Slow Stitch Embroidered Rabbit

## Class Description/Outline:

Slow stitching is the age-old process of mindful embroidery to repair an existing item, reclaim old materials, or use items on hand to make something new. This craft is VERY beginner friendly, you do not need to have sewn at all. The simple stitches needed will be taught in class to recreate the sample or to make an item that is entirely your own idea. You will also be shown how to layer and piece together the fabrics and materials of your choosing for a beautiful result. This piece will be an adorable addition to your home decor. You may purchase an inexpensive kit (\$5 or less) with cash at the time of class to exactly duplicate the sample, bring materials from home, and/or purchase the materials at the store with the class coupon.

## **Supplies Required:**

- Fabric (in the kit, from home, or the store)
- 1 Piece of 12x18" felt (baby blue if following the sample)
- Embroidery Floss (1 skein Weeks Dye Works "Celebration" if following sample)
- "Bits and bobs" (beads, ribbon, thread, buttons... in the kit, from home, or the store)
- Scissors
- Sewing Pins or Clips
- Embroidery Needle
- Beading needle if using beads
- Magnifier (Optional)

## Out of respect for instructors and other students who may suffer from allergies and sensitivities, please refrain from the use of perfumes or other heavily scented products on your class day. Thanks so much!

**Class policies:** Class Fees must be pre-paid and **minimum enrollment must be met** for all classes **48 hours prior** to schedule.
