Class Description/Outline:

Come join our watercolor class! We will be using a limited palette of colors to learn wet on wet techniques, painting watercolors with palette knives and blending on paper to create a harmonious and fun watercolor painting. Finished painting will be approximately 5x7 inches.

Supplies Required:

Arches watercolor paper, approximate sixe 5x7

Watercolor palette (one that has individual placements for the paint and a tray to mix paint-the bigger the better!)

Water bowl or bucket (the bigger the better!)

Daniel Smith or Winsor Newton Watercolor paints: sap green, rose, new gamboge/azo yellow, violet,

cerulean blue (or any other colors/replacement colors of your choosing)

1 inch painter's tape

Watercolor round brush (#4-8 is fine, NOT hog hair/bristle brush)

Palette Knives (metal is best, selection of shapes is nice but at least 1 that has straight edges)

No.2 & 6B graphite pencil (optional)

Pencil sharpener (optional)

Eraser (optional, white or kneaded is fine, NOT pink)

Micron 05 black pen (optional)

*paper towels provided
