Class Description/Outline:

Weaving is a fun hobby that opens up so many opportunities for crafting. But what if you don't have a loom? This workshop will walk you through the steps to make a weighted loom with just a few common items, how to make your own cards/tablets for tablet weaving, how to set up your tablets and yarn, how to read a tablet weaving pattern, AND how to weave a narrow band that you will then make into a bracelet. You will then be able to take your supplies and new knowledge home to weave more bands that could be bracelets, belts, straps or whatever you can think of.

Supplies Required:

- 2-4 colors, 1 skein each, of strong light weight yarn (Coboo is great, Minikins works nicely also)
- 3 large flat craft sticks (or 2 large and 1 extra large)
- 1-2 extra small to small craft sticks
- 2 large binder clips
- 1 piece 12x12" white chipboard
- Heavy Scissors
- Black Sharpie
- Large Crewel or Tapestry Needle
- Sewing Thread on a spool (I prefer Button Thread)
- Sewing Needle
- Clamp End w/Extension Chain, Parachute Buckle or other hardware to finish the bracelet

Feel free to bring a snack and/or a drink. We will take breaks for our bodies and brains during the workshop.
