Beginning Quilting 4-Part Series

Welcome to Beginning Quilting! We are going to work through 2 different projects in this 4 part class. We will be getting a good start on both projects in class, if you want to complete the projects, you will need to work on them at home as well. The first project will be a quilted table runner – this can be made into a small baby quilt if you would rather make that. The second project will be a throw size quilt. I will be going over the supply list for each project. If you have any questions about these items email me @ fabric@bfranklincrafts.com or come into the store. Any of us at the cutting table would be happy to walk through each of these items with you. You will need to bring your sewing machine to each class. We have cutting boards, irons and ironing boards in class. Feel free to bring your own personal iron, ironing mat and cutting mat if you want. This class is not a beginning sewing class. You will need to have a working knowledge of your machine and basic sewing skills.

Basic Sewing Tools – Please bring to each class

- Sewing Machine with a ¼" foot (if you don't know if you have a ¼" foot or need to purchase one Countryside Sewing and Vacuum in Monroe is a great option. I prefer the ¼" foot with a guide.
- Scissors/rotary cutter
- Pins
- Coordinating thread
- Seam Ripper
- Marking tool/pencil.
- Hand Sewing Needles

There will be cutting and sewing expected at home. If you need to purchase a cutting mat/ruler to use at home there are combo packs that make it easy. Fiskars makes one with a 18" x 24" mat, a ruler and rotary cutter. Olfa makes one with a 12" x 18" mat, a ruler and a rotary cutter. You can purchase each of these items individually also.

Table Runner or Baby Quilt - (class 1 and 2)

The batting and backing are not necessary for the first class. If you would like to wait to purchase them that is ok. We will discuss options for them in class and the different types of products for each. If you would like to purchase them ahead of time we will be happy to help you pick the best product for your project at the cutting table.

- 1 charm pack (a pre-cut pack of 42 5" squares)
- 1/3 yd. coordinating fabric for the border
- 1/3 yd coordinating fabric for the binding
- 4.5" x 8.5" or 4.5" x 12.5" quilting ruler. If you have a larger size, that will work, this size is my favorite.
- Batting 22" x 48" for the table runner, 31" x 36" for the baby quilt
- Backing – same size as your batting.
- 505 basting spray or large pkg of quilting safety pins. (basting spray is my preferred method) these will be used for both projects
- Thread. You will need thread in a neutral color for sewing your pieces together and thread that coordinates with your fabrics for the quilting. We will talk about the different types of thread in class as well. (continue to next page)

Throw Quilt (Class 3 and 4)

These can be purchased prior to the 3rd class. We will discuss the pattern choice and how to choose fabric for a quilt in class.

- 3 yard quilt book Easy Peasy 3 Yard Quilts (Town Square Pattern)
- (3) 1 yard cuts of fabric or a 3 yard quilt kit (you might want to get a ¼ yard extra of your binding fabric)
- Batting 54" x 72"
- Backing 2 yards of 60" wide (cuddle) or 1.5 yds of 108" quilt back or 3 yd of 45" wide fabric
- Coordinating thread for piecing and quilting
- 6.5" x 24.5" ruler. (we have them to use in class. If you want one for home this is recommended)

We will be talking about other tools throughout the class. The items above are tools that you will need, the other items will depend on personal preference and are able to purchase during class if desired.

COUPON:

Stop by our customer service desk to pick up your coupon that will go towards your purchases for the class.

CANCELATION POLICIES:

Minimum enrollment must be met for all classes 48 hour prior to schedule time or the class will be canceled. If you are interested in a class, please pre-register and prepay for the class 48 hours before the class date.

In the event that you cannot attend a class, your fee may be credited to another class or refunded ONLY if you notify the store at 360-794-6745 at LEAST 48 hours in advance of the class date.
