Crossbody Bag

Supply List:

Pattern:

- I will be providing a free pattern from Sew Powerful. There are 2 size options. The regular size Crossbody Bag is approximately 9"x8"x2". The large size Crossbody Bag is approximately 11"x10"x3".

Fabric Choices:

- Quilting Cotton works great for the Body and Lining of the Crossbody Bag - Choose a great body fabric and a coordinating pop of color for the inside lining!

- Medium weight woven home decorator fabrics are also a great option for the Bag body (I would choose a lighter weight fabric for the lining though). If using a heavier body fabric, you may not need as much interfacing (if you can hold off on purchasing interfacing until class where we can evaluate your fabric and then you can run downstairs and buy what you need).

I would avoid stretch fabrics or slippery fabrics such as satin or velvet.

YOU WILL NEED:

Body Fabric:

(Buy a little extra fabric if you have a large print motif that you want to center as a feature)

- Regular-sized bag:

- 1/2 yard of 42-44" wide fabric or 1/3 yard of 58-60" wide fabric

- Large-sized bag:

- 2/3 yard of 42-44" wide fabric or 1/2 yard of 58-60" wide fabric

Lining Fabric:

- Regular-sized bag:

- 1/2 yard of 42-44" wide fabric or 1/3 yard of 58-60" wide fabric

- Large-sized bag:

- 2/3 yard of 42-44" wide fabric or 1/2 yard of 58-60" wide fabric

Bag Strap:

- 1 1/2 yards of 1 inch (or slightly wider) cotton webbing - coordinate it with your bag fabric. Ben Franklin has some new patterned webbing as well as solid colors! I prefer cotton webbing as it is easier to sew and has a lovely feel. You can choose to use a polypropylene webbing, but the ends need to be burned prior to use.

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Interfacing:

You will need a medium to heavy weight fusible interfacing such as Pellon Craft Fuse. Anything equivalent is great!

- Regular-sized bag:

- 1/3 yard of 45" wide or 1/2" of 20" wide

Large-size bag:

- 3/8 yard of 45" wide or 3/4 yard of 20" wide

Equipment to Bring:

- Sewing Machine
- Sewing Pins
- Hand Sewing Needles
- Coordinating Thread
- Seam Gauge
- Sharp Sewing Scissors
- Seam Ripper (just in case!)
- Fabric Marker (like a chalk pencil or friction marker)

Fabric Prep: Please prep fabric before class!

-Please prewash and dry fabric before coming to class. (Check end of bolt or internet for appropriate wash/dry temperatures for your fabric type. If the bolt states "Dry Clean Only," do not wash! Wovens will shrink sometimes a little, sometimes a lot, and you don't want shrinkage to distort your project after it finished so bring to class prewashed. Wash like colors together in case of bleeding.

- DO NOT WASH WEBBING OR INTERFACING!

COUPON:

Stop by our customer service desk to pick up your coupon that will go towards your purchases for the class.

CANCELATION POLICIES:

Minimum enrollment must be met for all classes 48 hour prior to schedule time or the class will be canceled. If you are interested in a class, please pre-register and prepay for the class 48 hours before the class date.

In the event that you cannot attend a class, your fee may be credited to another class or refunded ONLY if you notify the store at 360-794-6745 at LEAST 48 hours in advance of the class date. You must have a cancellation number to verify this. If you don't follow this procedure you will forfeit your class fee.
