## **Intermediate Knitting: Round and Round: My First Beanie (Two parts)**

- One ball (100 g or more) of worsted or light worsted weight yarn, preferably Cascade 220 Superwash. Cascade 220 Superwash is available in any color of the rainbow in store. It is a soft yarn that grows a bit when you block it, making it a great yarn for beginning knitters. Cascade Yarns is a family owned yarn company based in Seattle.

Note: Please be sure to pick up a ball of the Cascade 220 Superwash that is shaped like a donut, not the ones that are in long skeins (those are Cascade 220 and are not as soft or forgiving for beginners). I used color 1926.

Needles:

- 16" Circular needle (for the brim) in size 7.
- 16" Circular needle or interchangeable needles in size 8.
- Double pointed needles or a second circular needle in size 8 for making the crown.
- General knitting supplies: One stitch marker, yarn needle, scissors.

From instructor: Pattern & Pom-Pom will be provided in class.

### **COUPON:**
