

Train Diorama

Supplies:

- 12" Unfinished Wood Tray
- Green Felt (3 shades)
- Tree Cutout Shape
- 3" Wooden Train
- 2" Wooden Presents
- Posca Pen (white)
- 30ct Cool Firefly Lights
- Poly-Fil
- 1/2" White Pom Poms
- Paint (white and navy blue)
- Paint Brushes
- Your Choice Adhesive
- Scissors
- Pen

Directions:

- 1. Paint inside blue (avoid the inside bottom—this you will paint white for the base). Let dry.
- 2. Trace out trees on the green felt sheets. Then cut out.
- 3. Paint the outside of the tray blue (optional to paint the back). Let dry.
- 4. Use the white Posca Pen to draw various sized dots for falling snow. Additional instructions on the back.




- 5. Adhere trees to the inside of the tray.
- 6. Adhere lights to the inner, upper part of the tray and then adhere Poly-Fil on top of the lights to cover. Tip: fold lights to the length of tray and feed through the handle on either side to reduce visibility.
- 7. Adhere the train figurine to the present figurine. Then adhere both to the center base of the tray (add adhesive to the bottom and back side of the present and train wheels closest to the back).
- 8. Adhere white pom poms across the remaining bottom of the tray.
