

2023 Ben Franklin Saturday Sampler

Color Collage Tutorial- May

Block 5- Laurel (4)



Step 1-

Using the butterscotch and blue laurel fabrics make your half square triangles.
If you want more wiggle room, cut your squares at 2 1/2" instead of 2 3/8"

Step 2-

Square your blocks up and make a chunk like the picture below. Press your seams towards the blue fabric



Step 3-

Draw a diagonal line on the backside of the butterscotch squares. They will be paired with 2 green furrow rectangles.



Step 4-

Arrange your squares on the rectangles right sides together. Make sure the angle of the diagonal is going the right way. Sew on the line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from your sewn line towards the corner. Press towards the butterscotch corners. Press one side towards the corner and the other side away so your seams nestle together.



Step 5-

Sew the rectangles together and press your seam open. Repeat to make 16 units.



Step 6-

Sew your chunks together to get 2 rows like this. Press your seams away from the center.



Step 7-

Make your center row and press seams towards the center.



Step 8- Sew your rows together pressing towards the center.
