

Bridle Path August 3, 2024

Houses

We are working on houses in August and September. There are a total of 16 houses. You can do them all at once or stretch it out.

These houses use the templates to create the roof. I suggest tracing the template pieces onto template plastic and then using that to trace and cut your pieces. Your pattern will show the direction to press your seams. The pattern also shows the size that each section should be. Trim to this size. Don't skip this step  $\bigcirc$  Ask me how I know  $\bigcirc$  Ha Ha Ha!

### Step 1

Cut your pieces out of the templates. Template B, C, and D can be cut with the fabric stacked. (C and D are reversed images of eachother so it works)

A needs to be cut with right side of fabric facing up. Don't cut it with wrong sides together.... Trust Me  $\heartsuit$ 





Trim your pieced strip to 10.5" x 2 34"

## Step 2

Make your chimney strip using pieces E, M and F. Press towards the window pieces Trim to 10.5" x 2.75"



know it's wrinkly... I will press it before using it )

## Step 3

Sew a piece of fabric K onto each side of fabric L. Press away from the center.





Add a J piece to the top and bottom

Trim to 7.125" x 6"

Step 4

Make the door section using pieces H, I and G. Trim to 3 7/8" x 6"

#### Step 5

Put it all together.





Trim to 10.5" x 10.5"
